

## MATERIALS LIST

-Screens: Aluminum or wooden screen frames.

**-Table with hinge clamps**: Turn any surface into a screen printing setup with a two clamp set.

**-Squeegees**: Standard Traditional shape - 4-1/2" Poplar Complete squeegee MEDIUM blade Some recommended suppliers: victoryfactory.com, onestrokeinks.com, dickblick.com

-Ink: Speedball Permanent Acrylic Screen Printing Poster Ink Recommended supplier: dickblick.com

**-Film**: Specially formulated films for inkjet printers, or photocopied transparency sheets (copy shops offer this service) Supplier: victoryfactory.com, tubelite.com, local copy shops

**-Emulsion**: Speedball Diazo Photo Screen Printing Emulsion, Ulano Diazo Photo Emulsion Supplier: dickblick.com

-Reclaimer: Speedball Diazo Photo Emulsion Remover, Ulano Photo Emulsion Remover #4 Supplier: dickblick.com

**-Scoop coater**: A coater can help smoothly apply emulsion on your screen with no drips or gaps. Supplier: victoryfacory.com

**-Light bulb**: Eiko Supreme Photoflood Bulb, 250 watts / 120 Volts (other light sources are also available) Supplier: Murphy's Camera

## Other materials:

- -Glass: A simple sheet of glass for holding the film flat against the screen.
- -Timer: Used for screen exposure.
- -Packing or masking tape: Used to tape screen edges before printing.
- -Simple Green: Great for cleaning up inks on screens and squeegees.
- -Water: Used to wash-out screens after exposure, during cleaning and screen reclaiming. (We recommend high pressure, such as a pressure washer or powerful spray hose).
